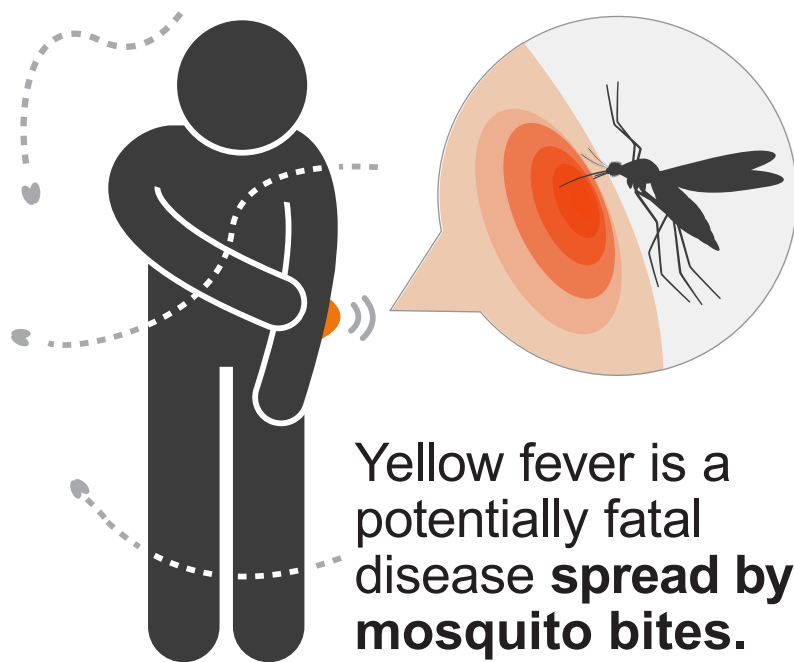


YELLOW FEVER FACTS



An estimated
84,000 - 170,000
yellow fever cases occur
every year.*

infected.

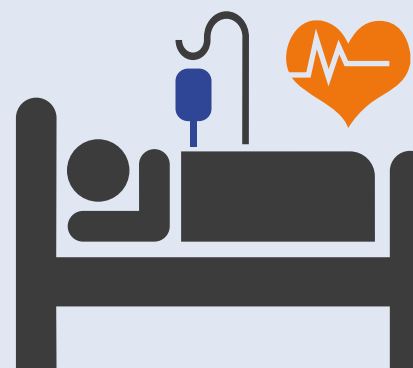


Up to

Most people have no symptoms.
If symptoms occur, they appear about
three to six days. Symptoms are similar
to many other illnesses, and include:

are **severe.**

have been **VACCINATED.**

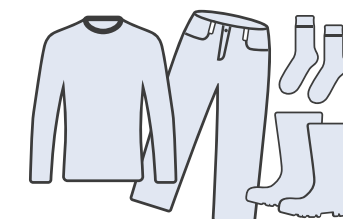
You may be **REQUIRED**

PREVENT MOSQUITO BITES



Use effective
insect repellent
that contains
DEET, Picaridin,
PMD or IR3535.



Wear **protective
clothing** (long pants
and sleeves, socks)
